

Ismael Rodríguez Laguna Profesor titular de universidad





Ismael Rodríguez is an associate professor in Dpt. Sistemas Informáticos y Computación, Universidad Complutense de Madrid (Spain). He obtained his MS degree in Computer Science in 2001 and his PhD in the same subject in 2004. Dr. Rodríguez received the best thesis award of Facultad de Informática (UCM) in 2004.

His research interests cover formal testing techniques, swarm and evolutionary optimization algorithms, computational complexity, formal methods, application of economic concepts to the design of computational systems, and functional programming.

Dr. Rodríguez has published more than one hundred papers in international refereed conferences and journals. He is member of the editorial board of Journal of Universal Computer Science and has been member of program committees in many international conferences. He has reviewed papers for many journal and international conferences. He has been the co-advisor of a PhD thesis, and is currently co-advising another one.

Dr. Rodríguez was co-chair of Dpt. Sistemas Informáticos y Computación for four years, and he has been member of many school and department work commissions. He was the project leader in two research projects funded by Comunidad de Madrid and Castilla-La Mancha regional governments, and he has been member of more that fifteen research projects.
